2. Images and artwork uploaded that are to be used in wrapped canvas will have portions of the image on the side of the canvas and portions that may be cropped off due to the shape of the canvas. I accept that I will carefully check the visual proof emailed to me indicates the approximate front face of the canvas and that I upon payment I accept the resulting canvas.
3. I will accept responsibility for any images or artwork provided and acknowledge that image quality issues including dark, over-exposed and out-of-focus images will print as such. I will not hold Streamline Enterprises or its affiliates responsible.
4. I hereby indemnify 1300anysigns.com and Streamline Enterprises Pty Ltd of any responsibility relating to the legality or copyright of any image or artwork supplied by me via this service. I accept that images that are deemed to be pornographic, illegal or defamatory may not be printed, at the sole discretion of the seller.
5. Canvas is a natural product and it is mounted by hand, consequently there will be minor imperfections in the print and manufacture that are considered part of the character of the product. I accept this and will not require refund, reprint or compensation for minor issues of this type.
6. I accept the lead time from placement of order will be 10 working days for Sydney Metro orders and 15 working days for regional and interstate orders. In rare circumstances this lead time may be greater dependent on external factors like order volumes, equipment failures and material availability and I accept this.
